Dear Customer,

on 8 June 2011 the European Parliament and the Council of the European Union adopted Directive 2011/65 / EU (RoHS) concerning the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment (EEE) placed in the European common market.

On March 31, 2015, the European Commission adopts the Directive 2015/863 / EU which complements Annex II of Directive 2011/65 / EU with 4 new SVHC substances.

Under this Directive is forbidden to enter on EU market new electrical and electronic (EEE) equipment containing:

- Lead (Pb) in concentrations greater than 0,1% by weight of homogeneous material;
- Mercury (Hg) in concentrations greater than 0.1% by weight of homogeneous material;
- Cadmium (Cd) in concentrations higher than 0.01% by weight of homogeneous material;
- Hexavalent chromium (Cr VI) in concentrations greater than 0.1% by weight of homogeneous material;
- Polychlorinated biphenyls (PBB) in concentrations greater than 0.1% by weight of homogeneous material;
- Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) in concentrations greater than 0.1% by weight of material;
- Bis (2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP) in concentrations higher than 0.1% by weight of material;
- Benzylbutyl phthalate (BBP) in concentrations higher than 0.1% by weight of material;
- Dibutylphthalate (DBP) in concentrations higher than 0.1% by weight of material;
- Di-isobutyl phthalate (DIBP) in concentrations higher than 0.1% by weight of material.

The 2015/863 / EU Directive entered into force on 24 June 2015 and the new restrictions will be applicable from 22 July 2019. However, there is a transitional period for medical devices and industrial monitoring and control instruments, for which the restrictions they will only apply from 22 July 2021.

Regardless of the time of application of the Directive 2015/863 / EU, all F.lli Giacomello srl products respect the limitations regarding dangerous substances regulated by it because in the production cycle, in the design and in the procurement we have opted for RoHS materials and components Compliant.

F.lli Giacomello srl will continue to produce in compliance with this Directive and of all major changes which may be involved and since now undertakes to apply, within the specified time frame, if they relate to their products more stringent.
